Sub:- Application of G.Anuradha Educational Trust seeking permission for establishment of a new Homoeopathic College namely Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bangalore with 60 seats in BHMS course under Section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 from the academic year 2019-20. - In compliance of order dated 18.02.2019 of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in W.P. No.47279-47280/2018 [EDN-REGP]. - LoI reg.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer your application dated 28.02.2019, received through the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India vide its letter No.R.12014/38/2016-EP- (II) dated 22.03.2019, in compliance of direction of Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka and to say that the proposal has been considered in this Council and inspection was carried out to examine the application on 03.06.2019.

2. After careful consideration of the scheme and taking into consideration the inspection report in terms of the regulation 6 and sub-regulation (1) of regulation 9 of regulations namely "Establishment of New Homoeopathy Medical College, (Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College) Regulations, 2011" (as amended up to 2018), provisions under the HCC Act, 1973, relevant regulations made thereunder; the Central Council has decided to issue a **Letter of Intent** to your Trust to establish **Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital at Bangalore with 60 seats in UG (BHMS) course**, under Section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 from the academic session 2019-20 subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before the inspection by the CCH in order to consider issuance of Letter of Permission (LoP) for the academic session 2019-20, failing which Letter of Permission (LoP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LoI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn:-

- (i) the college shall appoint all full time teachers and Guest Faculty in prescribed subjects and fulfill all the Minimum Standards Requirements in respect of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospital) Regulations, 2013, as amended upto 2019.
- (ii) the college shall maintain genuinely functional hospital with required average number of patients in OPD and IPD with required bed occupancy etc.

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- (iii) the applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely "Establishment of New Medical College (Opening of New Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College) Regulations, 2011", as amended upto 2018 and Homoeopathy (Degree Course) BHMS Regulations, 1983 (as amended upto 2019), before inspection for considering issuance of letter of permission.
- (iv) the applicant shall fulfill the requirement of all the relevant provisions under the HCC Act, 1973.

3. The applicant is also to submit the requisite performance bank guarantee of **Rupees One Crore** (required for starting new homoeopathy college up to 60 seats intake capacity) valid for a period of 5½ years as specified under the section 6 (1) (g) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2011" (as amended up to 2018).

4. The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted against the above mentioned course till the formal permission by issue of Letter of Permission (LoP) of the Central Government is granted.


5. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent, the LoI would automatically lapse and be treated cancelled without further reference to the applicant college.

6. The final decision will be taken subject to outcome of the pending writ in this regard.

7. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.

8. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
